

Bristol Grammar School 'A' level Results 2018

Students at Bristol Grammar School have achieved some excellent examination results.

54% of all grades were graded A*/A and 83% graded at A*–B, with a 100% success rate of A*–B in ten courses: Computer Science, Dance, Design & Technology: Product Design, French, Economics, Greek, Japanese, Latin, Music and Russian. 47 students gained three or more A*/A grades.
